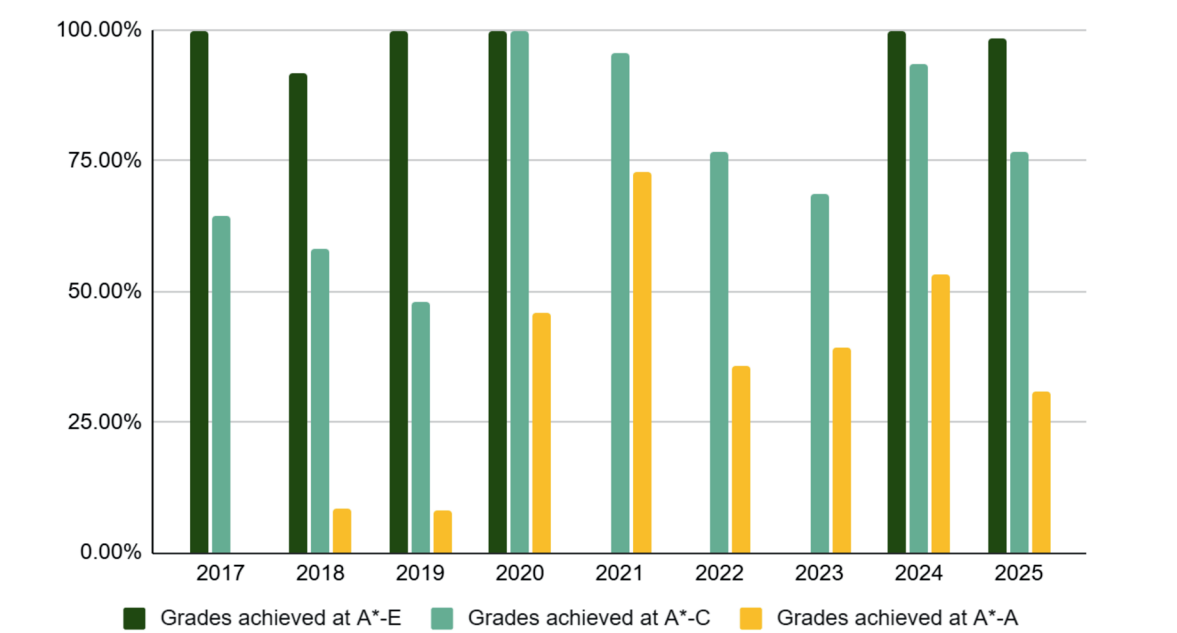

Past 9 Years' A Level Performance at Rockport School

The following table tracks our results from 2017 to 2025. Rockport students maintain a very strong pass rate, with almost 100% of grades achieved being A*-E. Almost a third of all grades achieved were A*-A.

How we compare - GCSE Results Summer 2025

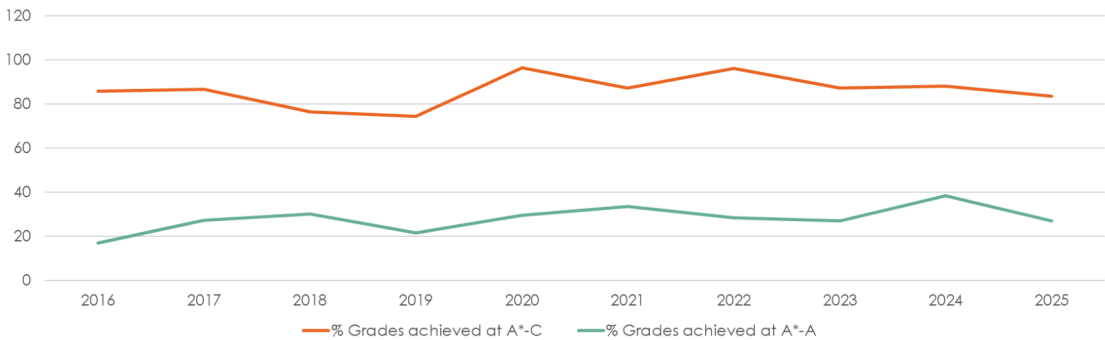
This table compares Rockport School pass rates with those of UK and Northern Irish schools. Particularly notable is that percentage pass rate at Rockport School outperforms the average across Northern Ireland and the UK. Rockport School also significantly outperforms the UK average at Grades A*-A, with 11.7% of grades achieved at A* or equivalent.

Value added measure at Student Level
